

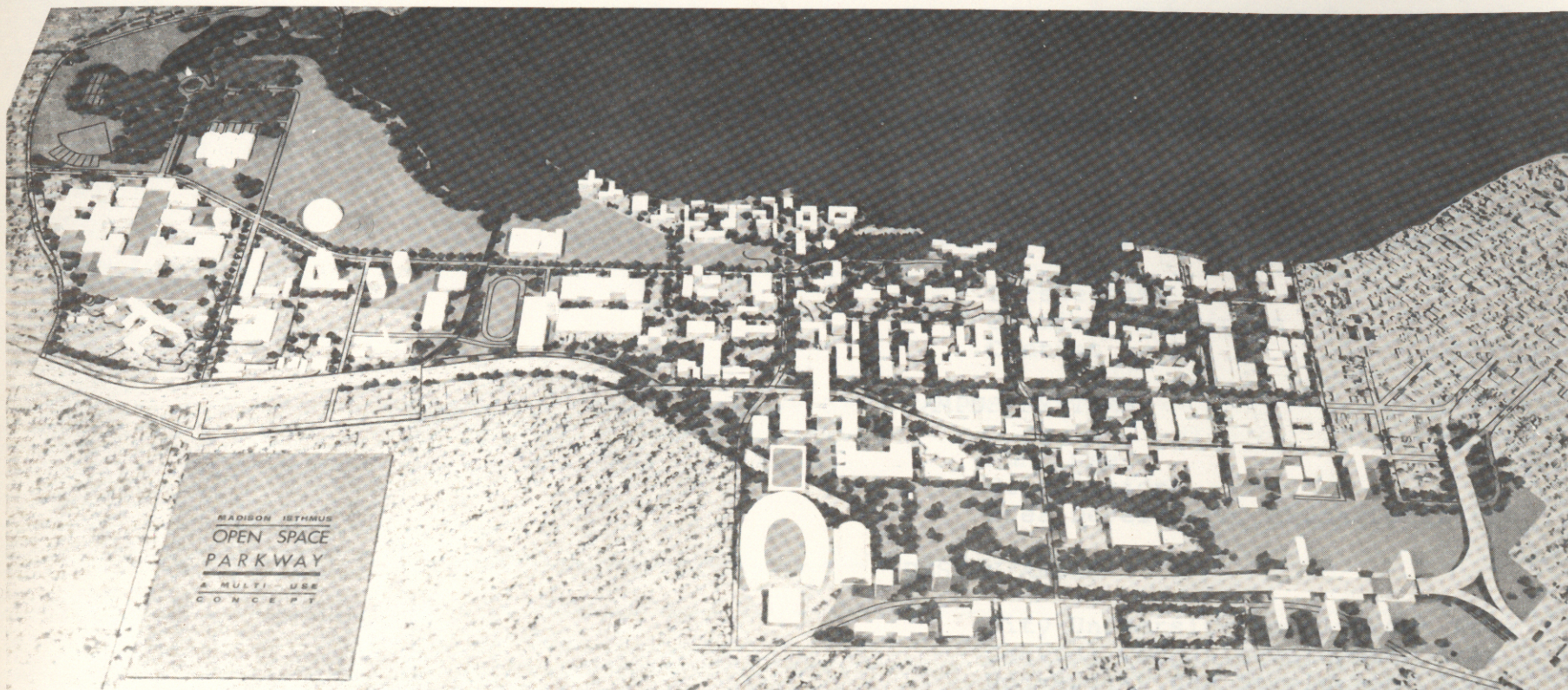
"UNIVERSITIES ARE TO OUR
